This policy is designed to address some of the barriers faced by women and girls in accessing and using community sport infrastructure. It ensures that their voices, concerns, and experiences are integral to policy design, implementation, and monitoring.

PANSA will create equivalent opportunities for female participants in all its program offerings.

PANSA will assist the community with co-designing and strengthening pathways for CaLD women to participate in culturally appropriate sport and recreation.

 - Equitable Access: Ensure women and girls have fair access to PANSA sport and recreation facilities.
 - Positive Participation Experiences: Foster positive sport and recreation experiences for women and girls.
 - Increased Utilization: Encourage greater engagement and use of sport and recreation facilities by women and girls.

 - Sport and active recreation play a vital role in our communities, promoting respect, well-being, and social connections.
 - Sport at all levels contributes to African community identity and pride.
 - Gender stereotypes and expectations play a significant role in reducing the benefits females can get in health and lifestyle outcomes and provision of culturally-informed opportunities can present an alternative choice for women.
